Massachusetts residents are urged to limit any out-of-State travel, and only travel to States designated as COVID-19 lower-risk States

Travel Order Simplified

- Anyone traveling from a state that is <u>not</u> considered "low-risk" as designated by the Department of Public Health, must submit to a COVID test up to 72 hours prior to arriving in Massachusetts or immediately upon arrival in MA. You must quarantine until you receive your test results. You must complete a MA Travel Form prior to arrival in MA unless you are visiting from a lower-risk state.
- Anyone arriving in Massachusetts after traveling internationally MUST fill out a MA Travel Form.

- Rapid tests are not allowed per Department of Public Health guidelines. Testing must be PCR, and if you choose to test upon arrival in Massachusetts, you <u>MUST</u> quarantine until you receive your test results.
- □ If you choose not to test, you MUST quarantine for 14 days after arriving back in Massachusetts.
- Individuals who do not comply with the requirement to quarantine are subject to a fine of \$500 per day.

Exemptions to the Travel Order

- □ Transitory Travel (people passing through MA). This exemption also applies to minor children traveling out of state to visit a non-custodial parent.
- Persons Commuting for Work or School (people who regularly commute weekly or more to a fixed place)
- **D** Patients Seeking or Receiving Medical Treatment
- □ Military Personnel
- **U** Workers Providing Critical Infrastructure Services

*Testing for children, 10 years and younger, who are traveling with an adult from their household is not required.

Test MV at Martha's Vineyard Regional High School

- □ No-cost, drive-thru diagnostic testing for COVID-19 if you are asymptomatic
- Open: Monday, Wednesday, and Friday from 9AM-12PM and 1PM-3:30PM.
- Testing is by appointment only. Everyone must pre-register.
