### BOARD OF SELECTMEN:

Isabel & Leyla will be working with Farland Corp. for their septic installation and hope to piggy back some of their work with the work at Winter House. They are aware of dumpster and disposal fees.

### ELECTRIC LIGHT:

The dedication of the solar field will take place on July 28.

### CONSERVATION COMMISSION:

The Buzzards Bay Coalition wants the Gosnold Conservation Commission to hold the conservation restriction for the piece of land on Bayberry Hill Road.

**PUMP OUT:**

Board of Health Agent, Karen Walesa inspected the pump out tank yesterday, which should be fully operational shortly. There will be a maintenance plan for the tank and equipment.

**POLICE/FIRE/1<sup>ST</sup> AID:**

Seth will become the Fire Chief as of July 1; his salary is based on 10 hours/week, and he will organize junior fire training during July & August.
